NEW BELL OF ST. MARY'S BLESSED BY BISHOP KELLEY

The new bell for St. Mary's church was blessed with imposing ceremonies by Rt. Rev. Bishop Kelley, Tuesday morning in the presence of a large audience. Bishop Kelley was assisted in the exercises by Ref. E. J. McCormick of Hubbardston, as celebrant, Rev. Chas. Ulenberg of Pewamo as deacon, and Rev. Dennis Beahan of Parnell as subdeacon. Bishop Kelley preached an eloquent and instructive sermon and at its close imparted his solemn blessing to the congregation.

The new bell is a fine one weighing 1500 pounds and has a splendid musical tone. It came to take the place of the bell purchased in 1905 and which was ruined about a year ago by being struck by lightning. The old bell was taken down Monday and the new one raised to its place in St. Mary's tower Tuesday morning, under the capable direction of E. A. Eldridge and his assistants.
